

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Health

January 9, 2013

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Health was called to order at 8 p.m. by the Vice President, Mrs. Carol Boyer in accordance with the Sunshine Law.

Regular Meeting

Upon roll call Mrs. Carol Boyer, Mr. Dorsi, Dr. Pien, Dr. Naik, Mr. Warren Hehl, Health Officer, De Zheng, Registered Health Inspector were present. Dr. Cohen, Dr. Pisano, Mr. Smalley and Mr. Tom Pirone were absent.

A motion was made by Mr. Dorsi; and seconded by Dr. Pien to approve the Minutes of December 12, 2012 Board of Health meeting. By unanimous vote all members were in favor.

Vice President's Report - Mrs. Carol Boyer

Mrs. Carol Boyer informed the Board that Dr. Cohen was doing well, but was in Utah with his son/family. A Motion was presented to the Board to elect Dr. Cohen as President for 2013 and Mrs. Carol Boyer as Vice President for 2013. By unanimous vote all BOH members were in favor. A Motion to approve Joann C. Roof as secretary to BOH for 2013 was presented to BOH members. By unanimous vote all members were in favor.

Health Officer – Warren Hehl

Mr. Warren Hehl informed the Board that the 2013 Contract between Berkeley Heights and Rahway for Health Services was approved. Mr. Hehl followed up with the municipality's requirement for garbage pickup. Mr. Hehl explained that (1) owner operator must remove waste two times a week or more if necessary; (2) Scavenger service be registered with Township and (3) Daily removal of trash from food establishments/public places.

Registered Environmental Health Specialist's Report – De Zheng

De told the Board, that East Restaurant had to be closed for one day; they did not comply with inspection requirements. Several issues with unsanitary conditions reported. De advised the Board he will do more frequent inspections at East Restaurant. De told the Board he inspected Deena's Delights (train station) and the official grand opening is scheduled for February 16th. Also, De reported that Yogoccino opened their second store. De will discuss further with the owner regarding the display of yogurt toppings. With so many children/individuals allergic to peanuts there is a concern with cross contamination, this issue needs to be re-addressed with the owner.

De informed the Board that Angelo Bonanno had inspected SMG's refrigeration problems at the salad bar and was addressed with the facility manager.

De discussed with Board members that a seminar is scheduled for September 11th in the Court Room, 6:30pm – 7:30pm with Board meeting scheduled afterwards. A flyer will be mailed out to all food establishments to attend.


General Communications
