The Regular Meeting of the Board of Health was called to order at 8 p.m. by the Vice President, Mrs. Carol Boyer in accordance with the Sunshine Law.

Regular Meeting

Upon roll call Mrs. Carol Boyer, Mr. Dorsi, Dr. Pien, Dr. Naik, Mr. Smalley Mr. Warren Hehl, Health Officer, De Zheng, Registered Health Inspector were present. Dr. Cohen, Dr. Pisano, and Mr. Tom Pirone were absent.

A motion was made by Mr. Dorsi; and seconded by Dr. Pien to approve the Minutes of February 13, 2013 Board of Health meeting. By unanimous vote all members were in favor.

Health Officer – Warren Hehl

Mr. Warren Hehl informed the Board he has been monitoring the flu outbreak. There has been a dramatic decline of any outbreaks, but if anyone needs a vaccination it is still available. Mr. Hehl also informed the Board that Runnells Hospital may be outsourcing. A question regarding fungal meningitis outbreak was asked. Mr. Hehl told the Board he attended a presentation at State Health Dept, and they didn't know how contaminated, but will continue to monitor. He explained some contamination occurs in the laboratory, where there's room for error, also not keeping track of lot numbers either.

Mr. Hehl shared the wonderful news that De passed his test as a Health Officer!

Registered Environmental Health Specialist's Report – De Zheng


