

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Health

April 10, 2013

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Health was called to order at 8 p.m. by the President, Dr. Cohen in accordance with the Sunshine Law.

Regular Meeting

Upon roll call Dr. Cohen, Mr. Dorsi, Dr. Naik, Mr. Tom Pirone, Mr. Smalley, Warren Hehl, Health Officer, and De Zheng, Registered Health Inspector were present. Mrs. Carol Boyer, Dr. Pien and Dr. Pisano, were absent.

A motion was made by Mr. Dorsi; and seconded by Dr. Naik to approve the Minutes of March 13, 2013 Board of Health meeting. By unanimous vote all members were in favor.

President's Report - Dr. Cohen

Dr. Cohen had notified the Board that Mrs. Carol Boyer was unable to attend the meeting.

Health Officer – Warren Hehl

Mr. Warren Hehl informed the Board the flu season was waning, but he will still be monitoring. Mr. Hehl mentioned there was an outbreak of mumps at the Univ. of Virginia and possible exposure of NJ residents. (Mr. Smalley suggested the following day to notify Berkeley Heights Superintendent of Schools, Ms. Rattner). Mr. Hehl also informed the Board there was a case of Equine Herpes Virus in Warren County. This being very contagious and spreads quickly from horse to horse.

Registered Environmental Health Specialist's Report – De Zheng

De informed the Board that the Mayor had a complaint regarding Domino's. De inspected and found nothing majorly wrong, items were organized, refrigerator temperature was correct. De inspected Connell Bldg. 100, and noted manager was not very responsive correcting violations. Refrigerator not working properly, salad bar out of temperature. De notified Board he will re-inspect the following week. De informed the Board that the Asian Market was to submit what kinds of foods they will be selling.

A discussion before the Board regarding the Rotary Club, Rubber Duck Event was heard. Mr. Tom Pirone made a Motion to waive the \$25 fee, non-profit event. All members voted, all but one agreed to waive the fee.

Citizens Hearing


