

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Health

May 15, 2013

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Health was called to order at 8 p.m. by the Vice President, Mrs. Carol Boyer in accordance with the Sunshine Law.

Regular Meeting

Upon roll call Mr. Dorsi, Mr. Smalley, Warren Hehl, Health Officer, and De Zheng, Registered Health Inspector were present. Dr. Cohen, Dr. Pien, Dr. Naik, Dr. Pisano and Tom Pirone were absent.

Mrs. Carol Boyer deferred a motion to approve Minutes of April 10, 2013 Board of Health meeting, since we did not have a quorum.

Vice President's Report – Mrs. Carol Boyer

Mrs. Carol Boyer informed the Board that Dr. Cohen is stepping down as President of the Board of Health. Dr. Cohen is no longer a resident of Berkeley Heights. Mrs. Boyer explained to the Board she will continue to fill in for Dr. Cohen until a new President is elected.

Health Officer – Warren Hehl

Mr. Warren Hehl informed the Board the CDC is discussing dropping the level from 10 to 5 for lead poisoning testing.

Registered Environmental Health Specialist's Report – De Zheng

De informed the Board that Garden State Brewfest was coordinated very well, using gloves when necessary and had hand washing facility. The (3) vendors who attended Brewfest had not provided their paperwork/check, were mailed applications which required a \$25 fee to be submitted. De also mentioned the Board had voted to waive the \$25 for the June 1st Rubber Duck Event. De noted for the June 8th Relay for Life event, any food establishments from Berkeley Heights were not required to pay a fee, since they already had paid for their 2013 food license.

De discussed with the Board a resident had a complaint when she purchased a bottle of soda and became ill. De notified the State and was sending an inspector to check the facility where soda was bottled. De notified the Board Krauszer's officially was closed. He also notified the Board members he will be inspecting all Berkeley Heights pools with the Memorial Day holiday approaching. A discussion with members regarding the September 11th seminar scheduled from 6-8pm for Berkeley Heights food establishments.

Mr. Smalley shared with the Board that when he makes a purchase at Noah's Bagels, sales purchase 'slip-on the other glove'.


Citizens Hearing
