

## Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Health

June 18, 2014

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Health was called to order at 8 p.m. by the President, Mr. Robert Dorsi in accordance with the Sunshine Law.

### Regular Meeting

Upon roll call Mrs. Carol Boyer, Mr. Robert Dorsi, Dr. Naik, Dr. Pien, Dr. Delio, Mr. Sorge, Mr. Tom Pirone, Mr. Warren Hehl, Health Officer, De Zheng, Registered Health Inspector were present. Mr. Smalley was unable to attend.

A motion was made by Mr. Dorsi, seconded by Mr. Sorge to approve the Minutes of May 21, 2014 meeting. By unanimous vote all members were in favor.

### President's Report – Robert Dorsi

Mr. Dorsi informed the Board that New China Wok Restaurant had opened.

### Health Officer – Warren Hehl

Mr. Warren Hehl informed the Board that there were no additional cases of gastrointestinal virus at Runnells Hospital. Mr. Hehl also mentioned that the initial case of MRSA at Scotch Plains did not occur.

### Registered Environmental Health Specialist's Report – De Zheng

De Zheng notified the Board that Angelo Bonanno had inspected East Restaurant where a violation was sited and a letter was mailed out to both East Restaurant and to their exterminator. Mr. Bonanno also inspected Country Farms Store and Noah's Bagels, both establishments were sited with unsanitary conditions. Both establishments were sent a violation letter.

De informed the Board that on June 29<sup>th</sup>, Berkeley Heights will have their annual Street Fair and on August 16<sup>th</sup>, there will be the Heights Fest event for all who are interested.

Nagoya Restaurant is planning to add a tiki bar to the outside of their restaurant, plans have been submitted.

De also notified the Board he has inspected all Berkeley Heights pools, but the first inspection reading at Berkeley Community pool failed at the kiddy pool. There also was a complaint at Mountain Avenue residence with overgrowth of poison ivy. De will be inspecting property and speaking with landscaper.

Neelam Restaurant had a grease trap problem, but their plumber acquired the necessary permits and will complete the job.


