

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Health**

**November 18, 2015**

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Health was called to order at 8 p.m. by the President, Mr. Bob Dorsi in accordance with the Sunshine Law.

**Regular Meeting**

Upon roll call Mrs. Carol Boyer, Mr. Bob Dorsi, Mr. Denis Smalley, Dr. Gary Pien, Dr. Connie Delio, Mr. Tom Pirone, Warren Hehl, Health Officer, and De Zheng, Registered Environmental Health Specialist were present. Dr. Komal Naik and Mr. Ed. Sorge were unable to attend.

A Motion was made by Mr. Bob Dorsi to approve the Minutes of October 21, 2015 meeting and Seconded by Mr. Denis Smalley and Dr. Connie Delio. By unanimous vote all members were in favor.

**Health Officer – Warren Hehl**

De Zheng, Health Inspector updated the Board that he and Mr. Tom McAndrew are at the completion of the Grease Trap Program with all our establishments and schools.

De informed the Board that environmental inspections for all Berkeley Heights schools are almost complete.


De Zheng explained he issued a Conditional Satisfactory rating on one establishment which required a Court hearing.
